### **School Dinners**

We are delighted to present a new format School Lunch menu as from 5<sup>th</sup> September 2017. We are now offering a two week menu with a second choice, sandwich or jacket potato option every day of the week. Sally, our cook has worked very hard to devise a menu, with the approval of North Yorkshire County Caterers to suit the needs of the children in this school, knowing all their likes and dislikes! All school meals continue to be prepared to a high standard and will be nutritionally balanced and those children who have medically diagnosed dietary needs will be catered for.

We hope you will support us in helping your child to choose their option on a daily basis. Sally will go into the classrooms every morning to take their meal orders.

We have managed to avoid raising the price of school dinners for the past 4 plus years however we now need to do so as our costs have continued to go up. In order to cover this increased cost of ingredients we will be therefore increasing the cost of school dinners to £2.30 per day, which is £11.50 per week, £78.20 in advance to half-term on 20.10.17. The new menu will be unveiled next week!

Payments will be taken in advance as of September 2017 to avoid any lunch arrears.
