School Funding Crisis

This is very much in the news at the moment and schools face budget cuts which will create difficulties. Despite promises that school funding is ring-fenced, head teachers have been hit with a range of extra costs: higher contributions to national insurance and teachers' pensions, the introduction of the national living wage, pay rises and the apprenticeship levy. On top of all this, per-pupil funding is not rising in line with inflation. The National Audit Office estimates that this equates to cuts of 8% in real terms by 2019-20. Mr Bishop, Rev Freestone and myself attended a meeting in York on Friday to find out what can or cannot be done. We found out that it is inevitable that cuts will be made to all school budgets, but as parents, if you feel strongly enough, please contact your local MP. Please visit www.schoolcuts.org to get a feel of how cuts may affect schools in this area and indeed, the local authority. I can only assure you that the staff and governors of Slingsby work incredibly hard to ensure that public money is spent wisely, but if we don't have it, we can't afford it! Suffice to say, Mrs Magson has hidden the glue sticks!
