New gate and fence

We are very pleased to let you know that the new gate and fence are completed. The Reading Rooms will no longer be accessible from the road for any access other than in an emergency and all visitors must come to the **main door** to sign in or drop children off.

- ♣ Breakfast Rangers children will need to come to the **main door** for entrance. Mrs Swallow or myself will be in the school to open the door for you from 8am.
- At the end of each day Mr Smith and Class 3 will exit first and move to the left of the school on the Reading Rooms side. Class 2 will exit from the **main door** but will be supervised by Mrs Jordan and the children will remain inside the school until their parent/carer is seen. Class 1 children will continue to be picked up as normal from the side door. Whilst we appreciate there will be a lot of children leaving school at the same time we do not envisage this will be a problem for staff.
- ♣ Celebration Assembly on a Friday As there is no longer access via the Reading Rooms door we would like to invite parents to come to the main door from 2.50pm onwards. Following assembly, we ask that you leave promptly by the main door and congregate in the correct area for your child (see above).

Please can you ensure that you do not dash off with a child without the adult in charge knowing as we need to be sure everyone has gone with who they should have! Thank you for your understanding and patience.
