### **School Uniform Supplier**

Regrettably we have had notice that our current school uniform supplier, School Trends, has gone into administration but have been immediately bought by another company so their business is still active. We have not, however, been happy with their service and lengthy delivery times therefore we are taking this opportunity to look at other uniform providers. If you have recently ordered from 'School Trends' please do not worry, we will not close our account with them until all orders are complete. Wearing the correct uniform is not optional; it is a requirement of our school, as it is in all schools. Once our current stock of uniform in school has depleted, we will be in a position to inform you of a new supplier.

## Head Lice

Please be advised there has been a case of head lice in school. Please check your children's hair and all members of your family. You should treat head lice as soon as you spot them. The advice given by the school nurse is to use copious amounts of conditioner on the hair and to comb through the hair in sections to remove lice and eggs. If a child is known to have head lice this should be done every other day until no further head lice or egg cases are found. Following this ideally you should use a detection comb (again with conditioner) on a weekly basis and re-start the process if you find any head lice. If you prefer you can purchase over the counter head lice treatments but weekly detection combing is still required. These treatments don't prevent head lice and should only be used if a live louse has been found in a child's hair. Guidance can also be found on the NHS website There is no requirement to keep your child off school but if your child has got head lice please let us know and please ensure that long hair is tied back.
