#### **School Start Times**

Please be reminded that the school day begins at <u>8.50am</u>. Please ensure your child is at school <u>before 8.50am</u> to enable the teachers to settle their class and take the register without interruption so that learning can begin promptly. As you are all aware, the school day is jam packed and it is important to get each day off to a good start. Lateness also has a severe impact upon the school attendance data which is scrutinised by NYCC and OfSted.



#### **Attendance**

The overall school data for attendance is currently as follows: this term 96.56%, this academic year 97.14%. This includes late arrivals into school. We are obligated by NYCC to flag up absence rates of more than 10% for safeguarding purposes and NYCC can choose to intervene. Children with an absence rate of 10% or more will receive a letter notifying them that their attendance is low.



#### **School Meal Price Increase from September**

The cost of school meals as set by County Caterers and based upon school dinner uptakes is set to increase again in September. The school meal price will increase from £2.40 to £2.50.

#### **Charlie Mortimer Fund Auction**

The Charlie Mortimer Fund is 10 years old this year. It was founded by Steve and Davina Mortimer following the unexpected loss of their son in 2009. Since then the charity has worked tirelessly to support other grieving families that have lost a child. This has involved various projects over the years including providing specialist equipment to LGI PICU and funding respite days for bereaved parents (through care for the family). Over the last 2 years, the charity has produced a children's book and developed it into a children's resource bag for siblings that have lost a brother or sister. The resource is now being used countrywide by children's hospitals, maternity units, schools and children's hospices. The charity is holding a 10<sup>th</sup> celebration fund raising auction in August and the charity are looking for donations either for the auction (in the form of anything from hampers, vouchers and promises!) or to the raffle too. There is a basket in the reception area for those that would like to support this ongoing work for a charity that school supports wholeheartedly.
