#### **ParentPay Accounts**

There remains £1,716.00 outstanding debt on parent accounts on Parent Pay for dinners (£490.60) and clubs (£1,225.50). Please double check your accounts and click on *'active payments'* tab which lists everything that's owed, not just the lunch costs which show on the home page. The debt is simply not sustainable for school. May we remind you that accounts should be paid in advance. **Non-payment** <u>will</u> result in the NYCC debt collection service being activated this month. School will not hesitate to initiate this process.



## After-School Clubs starting from 9<sup>th</sup> September 2019 -subject to payment of accounts

Please be reminded that all club sessions must be paid in advance. There is outstanding debt from last year for clubs and school has to pay for staff to run these clubs, therefore we cannot afford to run clubs at a loss. Breakfast Club and Chill Club will currently run as usual but if arrears are not paid then this will have to be reviewed. Please ensure your ParentPay accounts are kept in credit. Moving forward, your child will not be able to attend a club if you are in arrears.

#### **Attendance**

We have a duty to report and monitor school attendance. In this last year we recorded our lowest attendance rate for six years. We fully appreciate that illness can occur, however, we have seen an increase in 'holiday in term time' requests which Governors require a full explanation for. School is bound by Government guidelines which are clear regarding exceptional circumstances and Mrs Metcalfe has shown empathy to genuine requests. We ask that you avoid putting Mrs

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Metcalfe in a difficult position when requesting holidays. Regarding illness, a note must be provided and the School Office informed on the day for safeguarding purposes. The School Office will ring you if we have not been contacted.
