Important information

- Please try and hear your child read each evening and comment in their reading diary, noting the pages they have read. In school, each week your child will be heard read once with a comprehension focus and once with an inference focus.
- Children will change their reading books when they have finished their current book.
- Spellings will be given to pupils every Tuesday and tested on the following Monday so they have the weekend to help learn them. Please encourage your child to complete their 'look, cover, write, check' grid and write 5 interesting sentences, using words from their list and a range of punctuation.
- Children will require their P.E bags in school **all week** - including a pair of socks. PE sessions for Class 4 are timetabled to take place every Monday and Wednesday.
- Please actively encourage your child to learn the multiplication tables thoroughly, as sound knowledge will help their confidence in many areas of mathematics.
