#### Think Before you Stop and Choose a Safer Spot

As a driver you have a responsibility to drive and park in a safe and considerate manner, if you don't you could be endangering lives. We have received further complaints from local residents about the speed of drivers and dangerous parking around school vicinity. Please park with care and help make the area near and around our school a safer place for our pupils. We would encourage you to walk part of the way to school by parking away from the school entrance down High Street. If you need to drive your child to school, for the safety of all our families, please remember:

- No parking on corners or junctions especially near the red telephone box
- Please do not block driveways
- **Do not** exceed the 30mph speed limit

The problem outside school only occurs for very short periods of time during term-time only. The school is part of the community and by working to support improved communication between parents, the school staff and local residents, we hope this will enable everyone to understand the problems from other's point of view. Please note: the School car park is for staff use only. Please do not park across the entrance or opposite the staff car park as staff need to get in and out at all times. The same area is also a bus stop and accessed by the local service bus, secondary school bus and library bus. By remembering these points you will improve the safety of the area surrounding your child's school.
