#### Malton Salvation Army's Christmas Present Appeal 2019

This year, school is participating in the Malton Salvation Army's Christmas Present Appeal 2019. The Malton Salvation Army is running its annual Christmas present appeal from 1<sup>st</sup> November until 14<sup>th</sup> December 2019 and ask that you will support us with this. You can support us by either donating NEW toys and/or gifts for children, or by collecting gifts on behalf of the appeal. Any donation of gifts suitable for children from age 0 -16, particularly for teenagers, will be greatly appreciated. All donation received will directly benefit those in need in our community. #### Parent Pay – NEW Bank Transfer and Auto Top-Ups

Parent Pay have introduced Bank Transfer which enables parents and carers to pay for any school item directly from their bank account and it is guaranteed by the Direct Debit service. There is no need to add or store debit or credit card details in ParentPay but it does require a Direct Debit mandate to be authorised by your bank before payments can be collected (up to 3 working days normally or 6 working days for initial setup). This allows parents and carers who do not have credit facilities to make online payments and enables new automated payment processes (e.g. auto top-up). As part of the Bank Transfer facility, Auto Top-Up assists parents and carers in ensuring their child's school meal balance is always in credit. It does so by allowing a payer to set a minimum balance threshold which, when breached, automatically credits the meal balance by a fixed amount (payer configurable) using a Balance Transfer payment. In order to use Auto Top-Up, payers are required to set up and submit a Bank Transfer Direct Debit mandate. Once complete the payer will have the option to use the auto top-up feature.
