After-School Clubs – please keep your account in credit

We are pleased to announce that debt for meals and clubs has substantially reduced this week which means that for now, clubs will continue but please note they are continuously under review by staff and Governors. Please remember to top up and keep your payment items in credit - there should be no debt! The outstanding debt for clubs this week stands at <u>£394</u> and <u>£165.90</u> for lunches. If your child attends clubs on a regular basis please can we ask that those parents set up balance alerts on their accounts and/or set up auto top-up's with the NEW Bank Transfer option (for more details please see the ParentPay section of the newsletter). School have staffing costs to cover these activities and if payments have not been kept up to date, the school Governors will have a difficult decision to make. There should be no debt.

Budget concerns

Our midway budget review has taken place for 2019/2020 by our Finance Officer and Mrs Metcalfe, both of whom forecast down the path of worst case scenario. The future does appear bleak for state primary schools especially because there are significant deficits in the main educational money pot at NYCC which has a direct impact on our income. We have been asked to give our views on a Consultation regarding future funding which we have done. As you may be aware, all the parties in the forthcoming election are making many promises but in our experience, they announce massive increases in funding for schools but what they do not announce is that they take it away in other areas so until we see solid action we must continue to tighten our purse strings. Our Finance Officer has praised Mrs Metcalfe for her very careful and considered spending and management of the school budget, however, we have to keep walking on a tightrope and remain hugely grateful for all your support, donations and paying credit on Parent Pay!
