- Welcome back everyone. We hope you had a lovely half term and stayed safe. Please do ask your children to continue to let Mrs Metcalfe and the teachers know what they have been up to by emailing <u>headteacher@slingsby.n-yorks.sch.uk</u>.
- We hope you have now all received and read the information sent out separately regarding the phased re-opening of school and we thank you for your support and patience.
- This week we finalised groupings, risk assessments and staffing with Governors based on your email feedback two weeks ago confirming who required a place. These parents have now received a confirmation email of their place in school and starting details. Unfortunately, at this time **we are unable to take any further children**. We will keep you informed with regard to additional places when the Government and Local Authority advise this is possible and we have further assessed the options.
- What many of us love about Slingsby School is its intimacy but in the current circumstances the size of
 our school is not ideal! You will appreciate we are very limited for space to allow for the social distancing
 and hygiene rules and therefore will not be able to accommodate everyone's needs. Safety is our priority.
 We will, however, do our best over the coming months and we remain positive and hopeful that one day
 soon it will be safe for our whole school family to be reunited!
- Home learning packs will continue to be added to the website for every year group each week.
- For those returning who have ordered school lunches, these will be a cold packed lunch provided by Ryedale School under the new temporary catering arrangement set up by North Yorkshire County Caterers. Lunch orders must be made at least a day in advance by contacting the School Office and can be paid for via ParentPay as normal. Food allergies/intolerances will be catered for.

- The School Office will not be re-opening to minimise the number of people on site as per the guidelines, but Miss Hope & Mrs Massey continue to work their usual school hours from home so if you have any urgent administration queries, please email <u>admin@slingsby.n-yorks.sch.uk</u>.
- The Year 5 Experience days at Malton School have sadly been postponed until further notice. They very much hope to be able to offer these to the current Year 5s next year and in the meantime ask that you enjoy looking at their website.
- All the Year 6 pupils going to Malton School should have received a letter rearranging the transition times this term. Please contact Malton School if you did not receive a letter. We have not yet received any information for pupils going to Ryedale School.
