### **School News**

- Staff are all busy beavering away and working hard towards the safe and full re-opening of school in September in line with the new Government Guidance which is released daily with updates. Please remember our hands are tied with Government guidelines, health and safety risk assessments, union advice and LA regulations. Please feel rest assured that we will provide you with any updates as soon as we can so you and your children are fully prepared for the return to school. Let's hope the R rate remains low for the foreseeable and there are no local spikes resulting in a local lockdown.
- Please be reminded that initially, there will be NO before or after school clubs in September to minimise
  the mixing of groups in accordance with the new Guidance and to allow for additional deep cleaning
  regimes. We will endeavour to reintroduce wrap-around care as soon as we can as we know how much
  many of you rely on it.
- Next week's newsletter will be the last one of the school year, however we expect to be in touch regarding our return before September 8th so please monitor your emails.
- Over the summer holidays, admin and Head Teacher emails will not be monitored every day but they will be checked intermittently throughout the 7-week period.
- Over the next week, Mrs Metcalfe and Mr Mortimer will be having scheduled online Zoom calls with all
  the new Reception starters and their parents/carers to introduce themselves and to hear all about the
  children, giving them and their parents/carers the opportunity to ask any questions they may have about
  their child starting school in September.
- Miss Hope and Mrs Massey have been compiling the September new Reception starter pack bundles
  which will all be delivered before the end of term. Please return the completed forms by either posting,
  popping it through the school letterbox or bringing it to school on your child's first day.
- Schools are not being expected to open over the summer holidays, and there is no expectation that schools should open for vulnerable children and children of critical workers over this period. NYCC are bringing together a directory for childcare which will hopefully support parents and carers for the summer holidays.
- The Government's COVID Summer Fund vouchers have now been ordered by school and the parents of those children who are eligible for benefits-related free school meals should receive their one-off eCode voucher via email on Monday 20<sup>th</sup> July.
- Mrs Metcalfe would like to Zoom as many children as possible over the next week, however appreciates that not all children will want to do this. If your child would like a Zoom from Mrs Metcalfe, please email admin by Friday July 10<sup>th</sup> at 3.30pm. Please include an email address to enable us to make the appointment so keep an eye on emails if you asked for one. Mrs Metcalfe has already Zoomed a number of children over lockdown and has enjoyed hearing about their activities. Unfortunately, whenever anyone walks past her gate her dogs go crazy, so be prepared for intermittent barking!

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## **Sustainable Travel Art Competition**

The NYCC Sustainable Travel Team has developed an exciting competition for young people to create a piece of bespoke artwork to inspire others to get more active through healthier, environmentally greener journeys. In recent months the Covid-19 pandemic has altered the way we do things but it has also seen people explore their local areas, walk and cycle more and try something new. The Sustainable Team want people to continue to walk and cycle for their journeys, not only to benefit themselves, but also their school and local community through cleaner air, less traffic and safer streets. Pupils are invited to get creative and provide a piece of artwork. It can be any material and any process, just as long as it's A4 landscape and can be framed. One winner will be selected from each Key Stage with 5 runners up from each Key Stage. The winning pupils' artwork will be showcased in a special art exhibition at County Hall, Northallerton. The winners will receive a £50 Amazon voucher and the runners up will each receive a £25 Amazon voucher, plus one overall winner will win a Scooter Pod for their school. Artists have until Friday 11<sup>th</sup> September to submit their artwork. This is a fabulous opportunity for the children to get creative and spread a positive message about the environment! #### **School Shop Update**

The cut-off date for guaranteed delivery of uniform ready for the start of next term is 29<sup>th</sup> July 2020. If School Shop have orders by this date, then they guarantee they will arrive in time for school starting. They have purposely brought this forward a little to ensure they can process any returns as they fully expect some parents who may have ordinarily ordered through the shop to order online this season. Their shop is open Mon-Fri and from 18<sup>th</sup> July they will start opening on Saturdays, however visits are by appointment only and appointments can be booked online through their website. If demand for appointments exceeds capacity they will look to open Sundays as well to create as many opportunities for parents to come to the shop. You can place an order and use their Click & Collect service. They will text you to advise when your order is complete. You don't need to make an appointment to collect your order as collections will be handled from their adjoining building so there will be no need to go into the store. They encourage parents to order as early as possible as it is likely to be a very busy season and they want to avoid letting anyone down.
