How can I use this with my children?

If your child has been joining in with the phase 3 phonics lessons with Maddison and Felix, you can use this pack to assess their current phonetic ability in order to see their progress and discover where they may need further support.

How does this help my children's learning?

This pack can help you determine which letter sounds your child is able to recognise and which letter sounds they may need more support with. You will also be able to identify the skills they need to work on next linked to letter formation as well as segmenting and blending for reading.

Ideas for further learning:

If your child finds it difficult to recognise some phase 3 letters and the sounds that they make, you can continue to use our **Phase 3 Phonics** resources to further develop your child's phonic knowledge and understanding.



Check Your Child's Phase 3 Phonics Skills

Once your child has been exposed to all of the sounds in phase 3 and they have been practising their blending and segmenting skills for reading and writing, you can then use this parent tick sheet to see where they are within their current learning.

You should expect a child to get very few ticks before starting phase 3 phonics. At the end of phase 3, children should be able to get almost all ticks, however all children are different and each child will progress at their own rate. In England, phase 3 phonics is usually taught to children in the final term of reception.

You can use the flashcards within this pack to see which phase 3 sounds and words your child is able to correctly identify and read. You can then use this sheet to record your findings. This process should help you to have a clearer idea of which sounds your child is most confident with and which sounds they could practise further.
