- Thank you to everyone for complying with the "Stay at Home" guidance for those displaying symptoms matching that of coronavirus. We understand it is very difficult to obtain a test, however, it is vital we all continue to comply with the Government guidance for the safety of our school community.
- Thank you for avoiding gathering outside of school. It is especially important now with the new Rule of 6.

 to read them. For anyone isolating at home, school work is also on the website and will be uploaded
 every Monday.
- Further to the letter from the teachers emailed on 11th September, please do not send in book bags or anything other than essential items. Ideally PE plimsols should be part of the standard PE kit and kept in school, however, if your child does need to use their home trainers for PE, these must come in a separate carrier bag on a Monday and can go home on a Friday. Please encourage your children to take responsibility for all their items and ensure everything is labelled including water bottles.
- We will not be sending Data Information Sheets home for you to check this year but if any of your
 personal contact details or dietary requirements have changed please notify the School Office via email.
 All Home-School Agreements and Behaviour Policies signed last year remain the same and we accept
 them as your continued consent for this year. If you require a reminder of the policies, they are available

School Coronavirus Symptoms Policy – Very Important

As a school we are following the DFE guidance for dealing with Coronavirus symptoms in school and we would be hugely grateful for your support and diligence in following the same.

If a child displays any of the following symptoms in school:

- A high temperature
- A new continuous cough
- A loss or change to sense of smell or taste
- Sickness or diarrhoea

The class teacher will discreetly take them from class and seat them in an office dedicated to quarantining with full ventilation. The office will telephone parents or the emergency contact provided and ask that the child is collected immediately. Parents should then follow the government Guidance for Households with Possible or Confirmed Coronavirus Infection. https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/covid-19-stay-at-home-guidance/stay-at-home-guidance-for-households-with-possible-coronavirus-covid-19-infection
You must book a test straight away and only leave the house to take the test. You must not have any visitors and anyone the child lives with or in their home support bubble, must also stay at home until the result is received. The school class bubble does not have to self- isolate at that point. You must notify school as soon as you receive your result and if positive, the child's whole class bubble will be told to self- isolate for 14 days.

If anyone in a child's household or home support bubble becomes symptomatic, school must be informed and the child must be kept at home until that person's test results are obtained. If anyone in a child's household or support bubble tests positive the child must stay at home for 14 days.
