Reading Games

Game ideas:

Buried Treasure. Sort the words (treasure) from the nonsense words (rubbish) by saying and blending the sounds to read words (phase 2 setting with letter sounds g,o,c,k,r,e,m,h).

Speed Trials. Say the sounds and click on the ticks. How many can you name?

Build a Rocket. For a challenge spell out the words and type in letters (grown up help may be needed)

Writing

Try using your name and some of the tricky words that we have learned in phonics to write short sentences;

the	I	go	me	to
I am...Lucy.	I can run.	I can hop.	I can jump etc.	I go to the park.

Maths

Use the numbers practised so far to add and take away using the '+' '-' and '=' signs

These could be photos of doubles with labels $2+2=4$ $3+3=6$ Or $6-3=3$ $4-2=2$

In the same way that we want to learn how to write words using the letter sounds learned, we also use the numbers learned to write number sentences to improve understanding of more/less and +/-.

Art

Draw pictures of yourself to go with the sentences written above. You might be running, jumping or swimming!
