Kitchen - **le cuisine**

Dining room - **la salle à manger**

Living room - **le salon**

Bathroom - **la salle de bains**

Toilet - **les toilettes**

Playroom - **la salle de jeu**

Hall - **le hall**

Basement - **le sous sol**

Attic - **le grenier**
