# **School News**

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# The Childhood Immunisation Team Survey

The Childhood Immunisation Team have set up a QR code system (see attached) and a web link <u>https://www.surveymonkey.co.uk/r/J5298JJ</u> to gain feedback following their visit to administer the flu vaccination to gain more of an understanding of the children's experience of their flu vaccination in school and use this to improve their service for next year. You can scan the QR code or access the web link and assist your child/children to answer the short survey on their experience of their vaccination with the nurses. It is a very short survey and should only take a couple of minutes to complete. The questions are aimed at primary school and year 7 children and they should be able to answer them guite confidently themselves. Younger children may need more support from a parent/carer

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A reminder that the children can post their Christmas cards to their friends on a Monday and Tuesday. To allow for the quarantine period, the teachers will then hand the cards out to the children on a Friday.
