It's important to keep using the words we have learnt to help us remember them, and to feel more confident when we use them.


A few weeks ago we learnt the word for the stationery and other things we use in school. How many can you remember?

Now try these questions.....





## I've done the first one for you.


Combien de *cahiers* y a-t-il? (how many notebooks are there?





Il y a *douze cahiers*. (There are twelve notebooks)

















Now try with objects at home. You can find different numbers of pens. Pencils and books or create a groups of different objects.
