- Children working at home will receive a telephone call from their teacher over the coming week to checkin. The number may show as withheld or unknown.
- From next week, everyone who is home learning should send in their daily work using the Class Dojo platform. The teachers will not have the time to reply and feedback every day because they are teaching in school and preparing the online work, but they will certainly respond weekly. This platform should only be used for uploading work. It is not to be used by parents to ask queries of teachers. Any queries should still be sent via admin@slingsby.n-yorks.sch.uk.
- For those children who are currently in school, please can you send your child/ren in with a winter PE kit
 if you haven't done so already. Also, if it snows again, please send your children in with wellies in a
 labelled carrier bag and with appropriate winter layers.
- For children who are eligible for benefits related Free School Meals (FSM) who are not currently in school, a letter was emailed on Tuesday regarding the provisions available. Please confirm your chosen provision with the school office as soon as possible.
- Children who are in Reception Year 1 and Year 2 who are currently attending school qualify for a Universal Free School Meal (UiFSM).
- We have had our annual full fire extinguisher and fire safety service this week.
- All staff are currently completing an updated 'Mindfulness in the Classroom' training course online.
