Activity 2

Say the sentence "A chip is hot". Be sure to repeat it together a number of times (you can use funny voices to make it more fun for the children).

Write the sentence down together on a piece of paper asking the children to help you remember the words and help you remember how to spell the different words. Read it through and ask the children to check all the words are there and it makes sense.

Turn the paper over and see if the children can write the sentence independently. If you can encourage them to use their phonics fingers to separate the sounds, that should help them.
