Learning activity

We are going to be looking at how we measure things. Have a selection of different items of differing size (e.g.pencil, book, car, envelope). Put two items alongside each other and ask the children to describe their length. Model the sentence "the ...is longer than the....., theis shorter than the...". Correct the children if they use bigger and smaller into using this mathematical language. The children in class were using bigger and smaller quite a lot yesterday and so it is important that the children understand that we need to be more specific about describing size and use this mathematical language.

Challenge: Can you try one of Miss Pearce's finger gym activities and make play dough snakes or pasta jewellery? Try the activity overleaf too.

Use playdough to make snakes of different lengths.
You can line them up or use household objects to compare the lengths.
