LO: I can join simple sentences to make compound sentences using *or*, *and* or *but*!

We are going to be thinking about ways in which we can join simple sentences into compound sentences to make our writing style more varied and more interesting.

Task:

Look at the sentences on the attached resource sheet. Can you match these to make compound sentences, using 'or', 'and' or 'but', and write them out?

Then, write new simple sentences with a Harry Potter theme on slips of paper.

When you have created at least 10, mix up the slips of paper and pick out random pairs to see what funny compound sentences you have made when you join them with 'or', 'and' or 'but'! Does it matter which order you put the two simple sentences in?

An extra challenge would be to write **10** compound sentences! (*you would need 20 simple sentences to try this*)
