

| Word | Definition |
|----------|---|
| Producer | A living thing that makes its own food. Most food chains start with a green plant, because plants make their own food from sunlight. |
| Consumer | A living thing that eats other plants and animals in the food chain. |
| Prey | The animals that predators eat |
| Predator | An animal that eats other animals in the food chain. |






