LO: I can use metaphors and similes in my writing.

Yesterday we learned about metaphors and similes. Today we are going to use these to write a short poem.

Your theme is 'My Pet'; don't worry if you don't have a pet. This is all about using your imagination, so your pet can be a real one, or something unusual, such as a crocodile.

You can write in any poetic style you like. It could rhyme but it doesn't have to. It might have a strong rhythm... but it might not.

Steps to success

- 1. Get a piece of paper to use as a planning sheet.
- 2. Start by picking an animal.
- 3. Describe your animal using metaphor ('my dog is a hairy rug') and similes ('my cat purrs like an engine').
- 4. Think about what happened next.... Then write it down.
- 5. If you want to include rhyme, then make a list of words on your plan that rhyme.
- 6. Write 4 lines. Or more if you like!
