Over the next few weeks we are going to be learning about animals in French. To begin with today we will look at the names of some animals, practice saying them and learn a song.

You will notice in front of some words either 'le or la' and either 'un or une' this is to show if a word is masculine or feminine. The ending of a French noun often changes, generally words ending in -e are **feminine** and words ending in a consonant are **masculine**. Dont worry too much about this today as every time when you learn a new word you will learn it with its masculine or feminine form. Lower down I've highlighted words that are feminine in pink and masculine in blue.

Read through the power point Les animaux

Now watch and listen to the song 'tu as un animal?' Watch it 2 times, it is quite catchy so you should soon find your self singing along.
