Description of the School

Hogwarts is a larger than average Wizarding institution that caters for Wizards and Witches from all backgrounds including muggle-borns. Its staff are on the whole very effective and consists of suitable teachers. However there are the exceptions of Professor Lupin (a werewolf), Alastor Moody (who turns out to be Barty Crouch Jr) and Professor Quirrel (He Who Should Not Be Named). These dangerous appointments to the teaching staff are putting the students at considerable risk.

Overall effectiveness of the school

Hogwarts is a good school with a good number of students finishing Hogwarts and gaining appointments in the Ministry of Magic. However, there are a few students who finish and then become evil wizards such as He Who Should Not Be Named and Lucius Malfoy.

Health and Safety

The students often leave wands unattended and will even do magic while not being supervised by an adult. The bludgers used in Quidditch are extremely hard and should be covered in cotton wool to be in keeping with Health and Safety regulations. Professor Snape's potions classroom is down a flight of very steep steps which should be made into an elevator as it would be very easy for a student to fall down these. The occurrence of several beasts in the school, including a troll, three-headed dog, dragons, cromantula (giant tarantula) and werewolves present a considerable risk to the students' safety.
