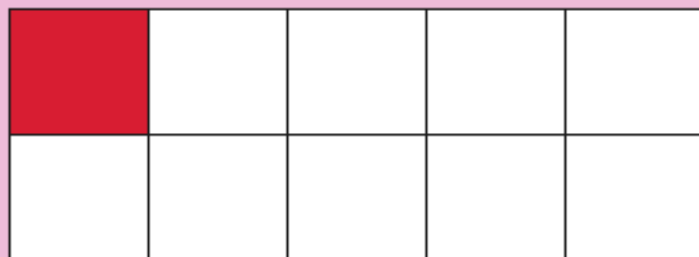
Problem Solving
