CLASS 1 "WHAT IS IT?" CHALLENGE

Why not be creative and have a go at making your own egg out of salt dough? Follow the instructions below and then decorate your egg any way you like. I would love to see what you come up with and what kind of creature might have left your egg!

- 1 cupful of plain flour (about 250g)
- half a cupful of table salt (about 125g)
- half a cupful of water (about 125ml)

Method

1. Preheat the oven to its lowest setting and line a baking sheet with baking parchment.
2. Mix the flour and salt in a large bowl. Add the water and stir until it comes together into a ball.
3. Transfer the dough to a floured work surface and shape into your chosen shape, or egg!
4. Put your finished items on the lined baking sheet and bake for 3 hrs or until solid.
