

Class 1 Maths

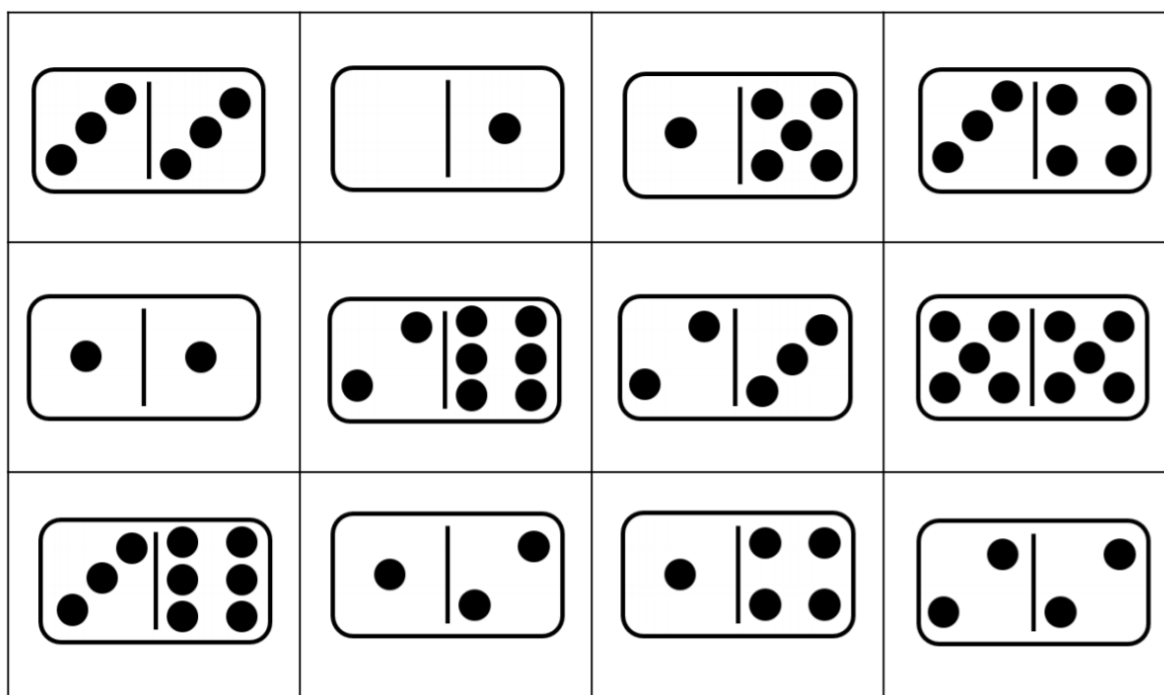
Warm up: Play one more, one less. Show the children a number on your fingers and ask them to show you the same, then one more and one less.

Activity: Today we are going to be comparing numbers and putting them into groups to show whether there are more or less.

Use this table to help you. Talk about the terms *less than/fewer*, *same as/equal to* and *more than/greater than* with the children. Can they tell you what they mean?

Less than	The same as	Greater than
-----------	-------------	--------------

Choose a number between 1 and 10. Using the dominoes ask the children to count the number on their domino and place them in the appropriate circle using stem sentence "...is ...than ...". By way of example if you choose the number 4 and then look at the first domino, the sentence would be "6 is greater than 4".
