#### Message from Mr. Smith

Firstly, I would like to say a huge 'Well Done!' to all our wonderful children at Slingsby School. You have been absolutely AMAZING over the last three weeks back in school and we are looking forward to all the exciting learning activities you'll hopefully be experiencing in the Summer term, provided National Covid-19 restrictions allow.

On behalf of the Friends of Slingsby School (FOSS), our Governing Body and all the staff, we are very excited to announce that, on Tuesday 6th April, we will be making some significant upgrades to our outdoor areas. These include: the resurfacing of the upper playground (to include a running/ride-on track and target zone); resurfacing of the area between Class 3 and our lovely nature area (to include a permanent hopscotch grid); and the development of a 'chill zone' to the rear of the Reading Rooms (currently Class 4).

The project is being part-funded with a significant contribution from the monies raised by the school community over the last 2-3 years through the hard work and dedication of the FOSS team. The one upside of the pandemic has also meant that we have not yet spent this year's PE and Sports Premium allocation on our usual expenses; therefore, we have been able to use a significant amount on the planned improvements to the outside areas. By incorporating markings, which encourage physical activity into the design of the playground surface, we have been able to ensure the project meets the funding allocation criteria. We have also taken the opportunity to purchase a range of new sport equipment for the children (including various heights of netball/basketball nets for all ages, balls, le-cross sticks, cricket and tennis equipment) - something we have not had the opportunity to do previously. We have no doubt the children will be as excited as we are when they return and can enjoy some great new play areas.

We would like to say a huge 'Thank You!' to the whole school community in making the financing of this project possible through all your support of FOSS fundraising over the last few years, which has enabled the school to make these improvements a reality.



#### School News

- Thank you to you all for your support in helping us get the children back to school these last three weeks.
   It has been wonderful to all be back together again. Please enjoy a break to re-charge and we very much look forward to a great summer term.
- We are looking forward to having a fun last day tomorrow where the children will be given lots of Easter
  activities, including decorating pebbles for the village Cairn, as well as showcasing their decorated masks
  kindly given by FOSS last week. As there is no end of term school assembly, we will be finishing at the
  usual times.
- Monday 12<sup>th</sup> April is a teacher training day. All children return to school on Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> April 2021.

- Some clubs will be resuming next term, subject to the latest Covid-19 guidance. Please see below for details.
- It is our intention next term to gradually expand the bubbles in school alongside the Government lifting of restrictions so that Class 1 & 2 will become one bubble and Class 3 & 4 will become one bubble, for the purposes of play times and some educational activities. However, we will be continuing to do everything we can to minimise the possible spread of the virus by maintaining Covid safe systems in line with our risk assessments. Please note that starting and finish times will remain the same as the Spring term.
- Short reports will be sent home at the beginning of next term and we will be discussing with parents/carers the provisions we have in place with regards to any areas of 'catch-up' that we consider are needed, having had this three-week period of assessment and review.
- Please be assured that also next term, subject to Covid-19 guidance and staffing, we are planning to resume PE lessons on the Sports field and tennis courts; host a whole school Sports Day; take each class on a planned educational visit; have school photograph; and also enjoy an end of year trip to Sandsend. We will be confirming all key dates at the beginning of next term.
- Everyone in Year 6 should have received a letter this week about the planned leavers' events and activities.
- A letter was emailed to all Year 5 parents/carers this week about the Experience Day at Malton School in June 2021.
- Year 4 and 5 hopefully all received a letter regarding the Peat Rigg residential in October 2021.
- We are pleased to confirm that we have appointed a new Midday Supervisory Assistant. Ms Wilson will be joining us after Easter when we look forward to giving her a great big Slingsby School welcome!

#### **Holiday Activities and Food Programme**

NYCC will be delivering a programme of support over Easter, through a combination of the extension of the Covid Winter Grant scheme food vouchers-for all families who have previously been in receipt of them-and age-appropriate Activity Packs for those statutory school-age children who are eligible for free school meals. Due to Department for Education criteria, the eligibility for Activity Packs is limited to statutory school-age children eligible for free school meals only. The eligibility framework for support through the Covid Winter Grant Scheme (i.e. supermarket vouchers) will retain the wider discretionary eligibility previously described. The packs have been put together by North Yorkshire Together (consortia of North Yorkshire Youth, North Yorkshire Sport and Rural Arts) and include a range of sports and craft materials, with a detailed booklet full of ideas for the school holidays. Food vouchers were processed and allocated today, prior to the Easter holidays and the activity packs will be handed out tomorrow.
