- A short 'blurb' on the back to hook the reader (there may be something about 'blurbs' in the English books I dropped off for you)

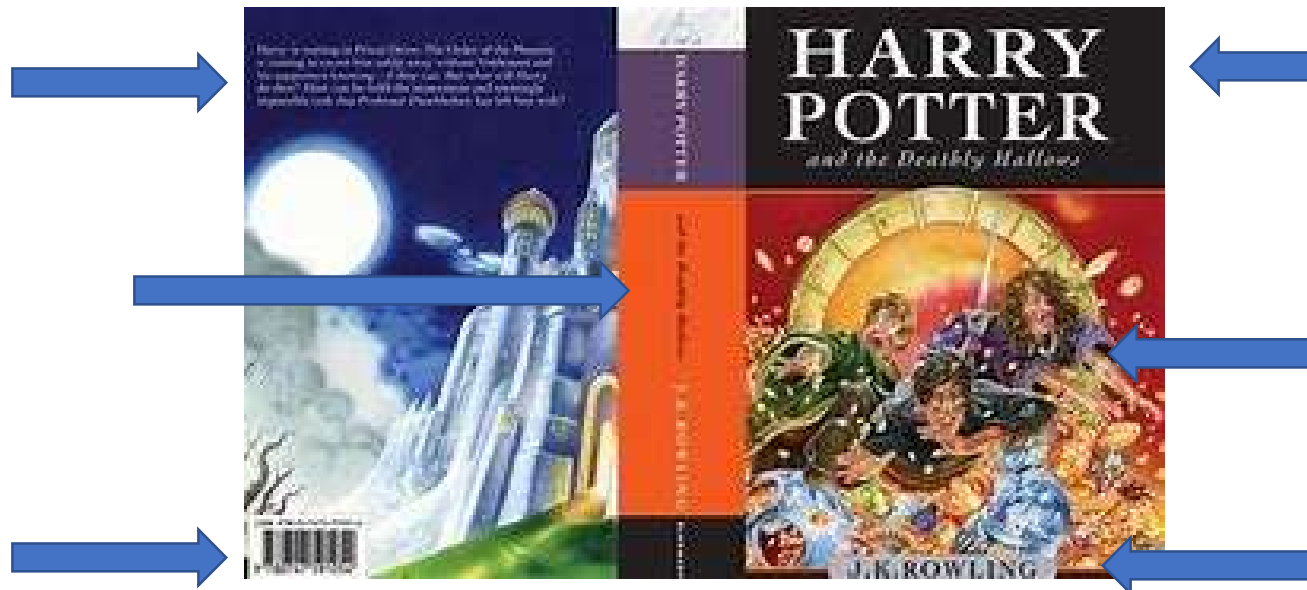
To help you get started, I've included a basic template on the next page. I can't wait to see your designs!

Blurb explains the story very quickly; engages the reader, but does not 'spoil' the story.

The spine has the story title, the author and the publisher of the book.
