# Message from Mr. Smith

We hope you all managed to have a great Easter break in the sunshine and snow! At school, we have had a very productive couple of weeks with the renovation of the new playground areas and planning for this term. - It remains our intention to gradually expand the bubbles in school, alongside the Government lifting of restrictions. Therefore, Class 1 & 2 are now one bubble as are Class 3 & 4 for the purposes of play times and some educational activities. We will continue to do everything we can to minimise the possible spread of the virus by maintaining Covid-19 safe systems in line with our risk assessments.
- With the lifting of restrictions, we can now start using the Sports Field and Tennis Courts once again for our PE sessions, with special thanks to the Sports and Social Club who have agreed we can resume using their toilet facilities following Covid hygiene practices. In light of this, please ensure your children have full PE kits in school every day. A reminder of what kit is needed is below.
- Please refer to our end of term newsletter on 25<sup>th</sup> March 2021 regarding club arrangements. At the moment, we ask that the wrap around care is only used for essential purposes to minimise the mixing of bubbles. Please book in advance where possible. We hope that full clubs will resume from 17<sup>th</sup> May, subject to the local and national Covid-19 guidance.
- The Summer term lunch menu and Term Dates for 2021/2022 are available to view on school website.
- Our new Midday Supervisor, Ms Wilson, started this week. Ms Wilson was very excited to join our school and has had a fabulous week getting to know the children.
- Class 2 enjoyed a Spring walk in the sunshine to see Mrs Swallow's eleven lambs at The Lawns in the village this week, which they then used as the basis of writing some wonderful Spring poetry.
- We would be very grateful for any unwanted old large (adult sized) t-shirts (preferably not collared shirts) which the children could use for art. All t-shirt donations will be guarantined for 72 hours before use.
- On Monday 5<sup>th</sup> April, the Prime Minister announced that from Friday 9<sup>th</sup> April, everyone in England (including those without symptoms) will be able to take a free rapid coronavirus (COVID-19) test twice a week. It is not mandatory, but it is recommended and as before we strongly encourage all our families to take part and please encourage your friends.
