# Parent Pay – end of term accounts

Our current debit is £995.22. As we approach the end of term, please ensure your Parent Pay accounts are paid up to date to assist with our end of academic year accounts. It will save us a lot of administration if accounts are in credit and there is no debt at the end of term! Remember that if you have credit you would like to move between clubs/payment items, please let the school office know what you would like transferring and we can do that for you. You can also set up an automatic bank transfer to keep your account items in credit and also a text reminder service to help remind you when your balance is low. Many thanks.



# Please take part in Lateral Flow Testing

Taking a lateral flow COVID-19 test twice a week, even if you do not have symptoms, will help school to prevent any potential outbreak and also will help the Government stay ahead of the spread of the virus, particularly as new strains appear. Around 1 in 3 people with COVID-19 have no symptoms and are spreading the virus without knowing. This includes those who have had their vaccine. If you or anyone in your family tests positive for Covid-19, or are asked to self-isolate, please let us know so that we can take the appropriate steps for track and trace.
