Message from Mr Smith

It has been another brilliant week in school. I really enjoyed taking the KS1 children up to Malton Community Sports Centre to play football and they scored some great goals! Please be aware that if your child has not chosen to attend one of the sporting events so far, there will be plenty more throughout the year – involving a multitude of different sports/activities: indeed, there will be something for everyone!

Thank you for your continued support in helping us to prevent an outbreak of Covid-19 in school; although, unfortunately, we have had one confirmed case in our setting today. All staff continue to undertake regular Lateral Flow tests and will now be wearing masks when they move throughout school. We continue to closely follow Government and NYCC advice.

If you or your children display any of the Covid-19 symptoms, please DO NOT send them in to school and take a free PCR test as soon as possible. Please ensure you practice regular hand washing and hygiene at home as we are in school. If children begin to display symptoms in school we will contact you and ask you to collect them immediately and book a free PCR test.
