Message from Mr Smith

Thank you to all who have been for PCR tests after receiving a close contact letter from us for Class 1 and 2 this week; it really does help to limit the spread through school, as some children can be asymptomatic and we are fortunate to have such an efficient test centre in Malton.

Following the Government's announcement over the weekend, we have received updated guidance from the DFE to reflect the change in measures for close contacts of suspected or confirmed Omicron cases (new South African variant). For everyone else, isolation rules are currently unchanged. Individuals are not required to self-isolate if they live in the same household as someone with COVID-19 who is not a suspected or confirmed case of the Omicron variant, or are a close contact of someone with COVID-19 who is not a suspected or confirmed case of the Omicron variant. We currently have THREE positive cases of Covid-19 in school as of today, none of which are confirmed case of the Omicron variant.

Children and young people aged under 18 years 6 months who usually attend school, and have been identified as a close contact of someone with COVID-19 who is not a suspected or confirmed case of the Omicron variant and who are asymptomatic, should continue to attend school as normal. Face coverings continue to be worn by staff and visitors when moving around in school and communal areas. Health advice continues to be that children in primary schools should not be asked to wear face coverings.

Pupils with a positive LFD test result should self-isolate in line with the stay at home guidance for households with possible or confirmed coronavirus (COVID-19) infection which can be found at https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/covid-19-stay-at-home-guidance/stay-at-home-guidance-for-households-with-possible-coronavirus-covid-19-infection. They will also need to get a free PCR test to check if they have COVID-19 https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test.

We continue to monitor the situation closely and very much hope that we will be able to proceed with our Christmas performances next week. Please continue to lateral flow twice weekly and we will be asking that any parents or carers attending the performances take a lateral flow before you come, not to attend if you are displaying any Covid-19 symptoms, and to wear a face covering throughout.
