Plan B - Important updated information about Covid-19

Please be aware of the updated Covid-19 guidance announced by the Government moving to Plan B in response to the Omicron variant.

We will continue to contact you via letter if your child/ren are identified as a close contact of anyone testing positive for Covid-19 in school and we ask that you take your child/ren for a PCR test as soon as possible when you receive that notification to help limit the spread in school. Lateral flow tests are not sufficient.

The current advice remains that children in primary schools who are identified as a close contact of someone with COVID-19 (who is not a suspected or confirmed case of the Omicron variant) should obtain a PCR test but can continue to attend school as normal if they are asymptomatic. If they have symptoms, they should isolate until they have their PCR results.

Pupils with a positive lateral flow test result should self-isolate in line with the stay at home guidance for households with possible or confirmed coronavirus (COVID-19) infection which can be found at https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/covid-19-stay-at-home-guidance-for-households-with-possible-coronavirus-covid-19-infection. They will also need to get a free PCR test to check if they have COVID-19 https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test.
