Your task is to plan a party within a given budget.

Scenario 1.)

The party is for 8 young children. You would like some sort of entertainment and games that have prizes. Obviously, you will be requiring food and drink too – and not forgetting, of course, a cake.

Your budget for the whole party is £ 100.

Scenario 2 – a BIGGER Occasion!!!!

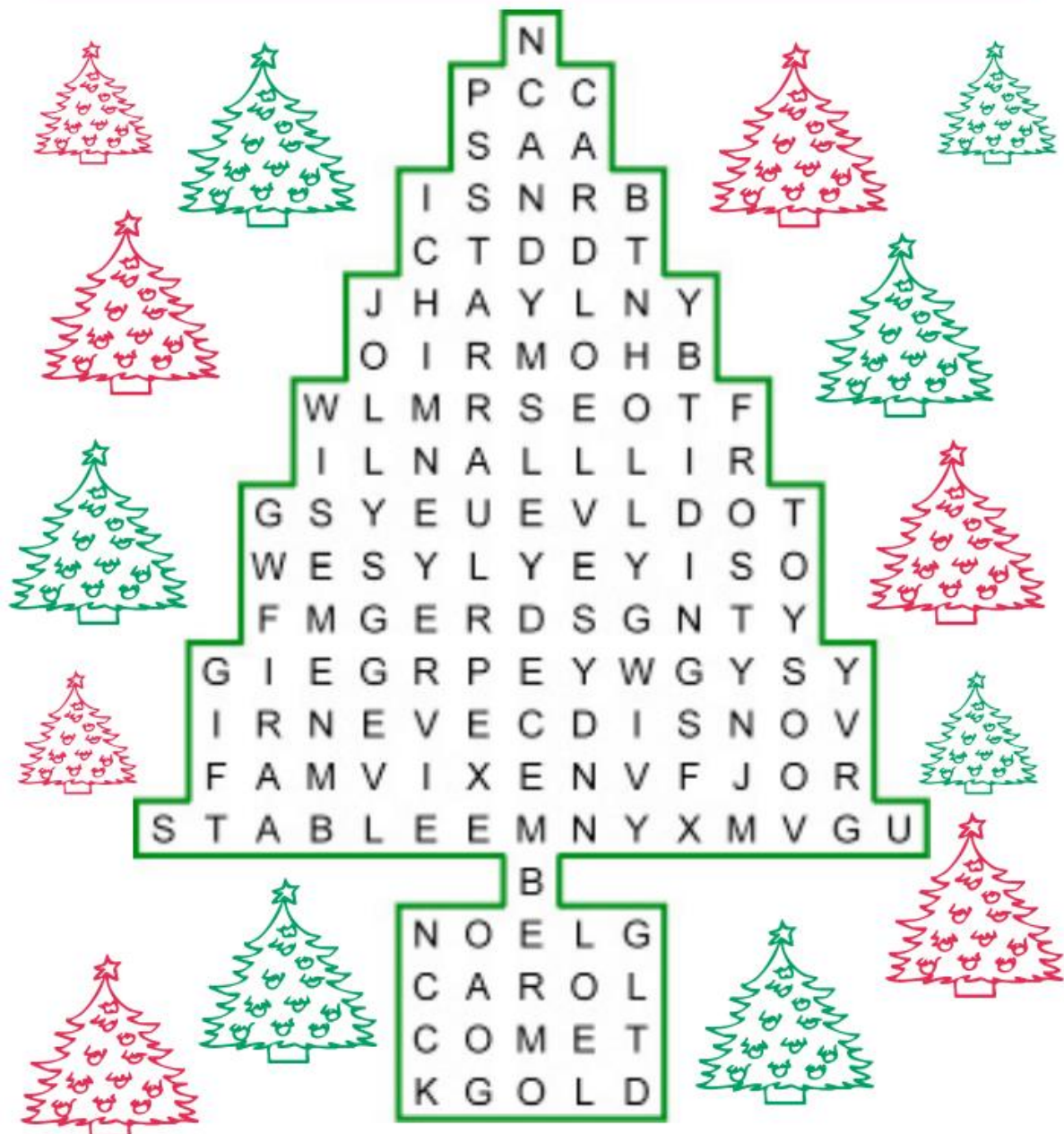
Organise a party for 25 young children within a budget of £150. The party lasts for approximately 3 hours.

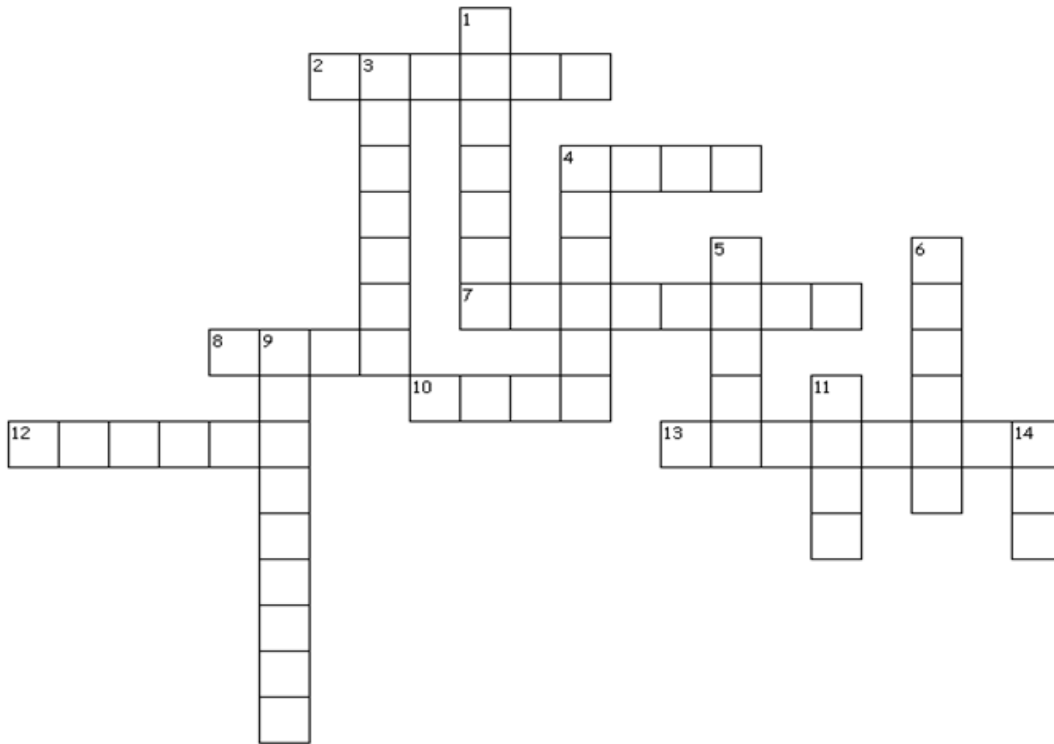
All of these words are hidden in the wordsearch below. How quickly can you find them?
