
Slingsby CP School Class 1 Curriculum Newsletter Spring 1

Literacy (Comprehension, word reading and writing) Y1: Our new year, castles fact file, instructions, comparing fiction texts, humorous poems, a recount. EYFS: our holidays, labels and captions, sequencing and retelling a story, performance, rhyming words.

Science (Understanding the World) Animals: mammals, birds and reptiles, fish and amphibians, what animals eat, how to take care of animals, data collection. Art/Design Technology (Expressive art and design) Create Bayeux pictures using lines; the Buck Brothers and James Paterson

History (Understanding the world) A study of Helmsley Castle. Maths (number and numerical patterns) Y1: consolidation place value within 20; addition and subtraction within 20; place value within 50. EYFS: comparing and composition numbers within 5; mass and capacity; 6,7,8; making pairs/combining two groups; length and height/time.

Geography (Understanding the World)

Location and physical features of castles; castles in the UK; maps.

<u>Important information</u> Class 1 will be taught by Miss Pearce, with teaching assistant support from Mrs Mitchell, Mrs Robshaw and Mrs McCandless. Please can reading books and records be brought into school daily, as each week your child will be heard to read within a group and on a one to one basis with another adult. Books will be changed every Friday. Please encourage your child to re-read books to support their fluency and confidence in word reading \cdot Children will require their P.E bags in school all week -PE sessions for Class 1 will take place every Monday. Children need a pair of trainers, socks, warm trousers and a jumper, as where possible PE will be outside. \cdot Merits will be awarded to the children for going above and beyond expectations and achieving the next step in their learning. Class dojos will be awarded to the children for behaviour, hard work, team work and being a good friend.
