Debt Owed

There is a current debt on Parent Pay of $\frac{f610.53}{f610.53}$ due for meals and clubs.

As a result of this continuous amount of debt, we are reviewing our booking and paying systems to ensure payment is made before a place is booked. It takes up a huge amount of administration time calculating individual debt, sending text reminders and having to instigate our debt collection process which we really do not enjoy doing. All meals and clubs should be paid for in advance and there should always be credit on your Parent Pay items that you use regularly.

You can set up an automatic bank transfer to keep specific payment items in credit at all times and you can also set up a text reminder service to remind you when your balance reaches a chosen amount.
