**Personal Data** – Think carefully about the information you share online about yourself. You shouldn't share personal information, such as your real name, your age, your address, phone number or which school you go to.

Inappropriate Material – Some things online are not appropriate for children to see. If you see something that upsets you, scares you or makes you feel uncomfortable, tell a grown-up straight away.
