The Importance of Labelling School Uniform

During the warmer months in school, children start taking layers off which results in an even bigger collection of lost property. As mentioned earlier, we have over 20 un-named and un-claimed school jumpers at the moment! In school, we teach the children how to be responsible for their own things and to keep items on their own pegs, but inevitably because they are so busy playing and having fun, that's not always put into practice. We understand the frustration and financial implication this can have on parents/carers/families when more often than not, children come home with less clothes than what they went in; that is why it's essential that ALL items of uniform are clearly named/labelled. If you have written your child's name on the inside white tag with a pen, please remember to rewrite it regularly as this can fade over time with washing. Our school uniform supplier offers personalised name labels which you iron on which are fantastic. Lost uniform is an ongoing battle in school and staff try to keep on top of this on a daily basis but if items are not labelled, it's an impossible task to know whose is whose. Unclaimed items eventually are passed to FOSS to sell on their pre-loved stall.
