### School News

- Please can we remind you that PE kits are needed in school <u>EVERY DAY</u> of the week, Monday through to Friday. Sports Day practices will be getting underway whenever we have a spare moment! PE is an essential part of our children's education and the correct PE kit ensures that your children can participate fully in all our activities, which sometimes are only decided on the day. Sun cream, sun hats and water bottles are also needed every day at this time of the year.
- We have seven confirmed cases of Chickenpox this week and three cases of Covid, so please keep an eye on your children for any symptoms. Children should not attend school for five days from the onset of a chickenpox rash and until all blisters have crusted over. With Covid, children should not attend school for three days and until they feel well.
- Our co-opted school governor, Reverend Robertson spent the afternoon in school on Monday
  for a governor visit focusing on RE and PSHE and speaking with the children. He thoroughly
  enjoyed his visit and we all enjoyed having him in school. We are looking forward to our Parent
  Governor Mr Storrar coming in on Monday.
- Our Year 5 children behaved exceptionally well during their Malton School experience day on Tuesday: well done, Year 5! In Science, the children got to use Bunsen burners to see what colours different chemicals burn. For Drama, Art and Music, all schools combined to perform The Lion King musical; and in Design and Technology, they got to design and make an acrylic keyring which they were allowed to keep.
