<u>Universal Infant Free School Meals (UiFSM) and FSM (Free School Meals)</u>

The Government provide funding for Universal Free School Meals for all children up to Year 2/Key Stage 1. From Year 3/Key Stage 2 lunches are charged at a rate of £2.66 a meal. This is different from Free School Meals (FSM) which are funded by the Local Authority to families who have applied and qualified for Pupil Premium funding support. If you wish to apply for Free School Meals/Pupil Premium support, the forms are available from the school office. If you qualify, you will also be entitled to funding towards clubs, trips, residentials and additional learning resources.
