# A Message from Mr Smith

It is a worrying time with the cost of living affecting us all and we wish to offer support to any of our families who are struggling. Please do reach out and speak to us, as there is help available for families in financial need.

We have noticed a downturn in payments towards transport costs to our extra-curricular activities and we rely completely on contributions from our families for the cost of buses and trips, as we receive no funding at all for this from the Government; so if we do not receive enough payments, we cannot go. However, if there is a collective feeling that we are asking families for too many payments for too many trips throughout the year, then we will work to adjust the number of excursions so please let us know if you think we are doing too much.

Similarly, we do not wish for any of our pupils to miss out on FOSS events due to costs. Our super FOSS always wish to help families and include everyone so please let us know if you need their assistance, such as for the Halloween party in a couple of weeks (more details below).

Sadly, the increased costs of living are also affecting school, as they are for all our families at home. The financial funding we receive from the Government is not changing but the costs of running the school continue to increase.

The forthcoming Parent Forum next Wednesday at 7pm will be the perfect opportunity for us to discuss the school's general approach to sporting events, trips and funding with you.



#### **School News**

- We are pleased to announce that Mrs Jordan has taken on the role of school SENco (Special Educational Needs Co-ordinator). She spent Wednesday afternoon at York St John's University to begin her NASENCO course qualification.
- Whilst Mrs Jordan was studying in York, Mr Smith had the opportunity to accompany the Class 2 children on their swimming session this week. He was massively impressed by the outstanding behaviour of the children and thoroughly enjoyed also listening to some rather impressive readers on the poolside!
- Our first Student School Council meeting took place on Friday with Mr Smith where the children representatives from each year group voted for their chairperson, the note taker, the frequency of meetings and the intention of the School Council. Watch this space for their reports!

- Reception baseline assessments took place last week and an external moderator from NYCC visited
  to observe the children in action with Miss Pearce. The moderator's feedback was hugely
  complimentary of our approach and standards, which was reassuring to hear.
- All classes have undertaken assessments this week in Maths and English and the teachers have been really proud of how hard all the children have worked.
- Our School Governor, Mr Thompson, was with us on Monday morning looking at mathematics and science.
- Year 3 & 4 took part in the Primary Games football and dodgeball tournaments yesterday, which involved 10 local schools. Whilst the boys and girls football teams did not manage to win any of their three games each, they certainly did themselves proud. Their attitude, effort and support for each other was absolutely fantastic even though the weather was not the best! Our dodgeball team were on fire and won all their games to qualify for the final which they narrowly lost. It was lovely to see every child smiling and commenting on what a great time they'd had. All our sport representatives also wore our 'all new' sport kits, which we were able to purchase through ring-fenced sport's funding.

### Flu Vaccinations - reminder

As per the letter sent out on 21<sup>st</sup> September 2022 and reminder this week, the flu vaccine will be offered to all primary school and SEND children up until the day before their 18th birthday this year. Nasal flu vaccination is delivered in school. There are some occasions where an injection is the most appropriate route for vaccination for some children. The consent form that the link below takes you to is for Nasal Flu, if you select NO, you will be asked a series of questions to establish if your child is eligible for an injection.
