#### School Closure Procedure in Case of Snow

A reminder that if school is unable to open due to bad winter weather, we will follow our Unavoidable School Closure procedures. Mr Smith will endeavour to speak to all staff and make the decision to close (or open later to allow time for melt or gritters) by 7.30am on the day, or failing that, as soon as is possible.

A message will be sent to all families via the Teachers2Parents (Eduspot) App Notice Board before 8am where possible. Please ensure your T2P App is set up to notify you when a message is received. This sometimes has to be re-set when telephone updates occur.

If the closure takes place during a school day, school will telephone the 'Unavoidable Closure' emergency contact that you provided in your starter pack so that arrangements for the collection and supervision of the children can be made. We will also send a message via the Teachers2Parents (Eduspot) App Notice Board.

In either circumstance, we will inform Greatest Hits Radio (as per the NYCC guidance) who announce the local school closures and notify NYCC who will post it on their website. In addition, a notice will be placed on the front door of the school and the scrolling ticker tape on the Homepage of the school's website will be updated to state that SCHOOL IS CLOSED.

Now that the cold weather is upon us, please make sure that your children are dressed in plenty of layers and bring winter coats, hats and gloves to school each day. If it is snowing, children should bring wellington boots in a labelled bag for break times.
