- We are looking forward to welcoming two final placement York St John PGCE Students next week who will be with us this term. Miss Timmin will be working alongside Miss Secker in Class 4 and Miss Sykes will be working alongside Mrs Jordan in Class 2.
- In the coming weeks, we will be practicing our school lockdown drill which is a Health & Safety
  requirement. Like a fire drill, the lockdown procedure is in place in case of a dangerous situation
  other than fire such as contamination, a swarm of wasps, air pollution or a threat of violence. This
  will be done with complete sensitivity and mostly requires discreet actions by staff, for example
  closing windows and blinds. For the children, it will simply involve them stopping what they are
  doing, sitting on the floor and being read a story, which we are sure they will enjoy.

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#### **Missing Uniform**

A number of parents have contacted school to report missing uniform from before Christmas. Please can we ask everyone to check uniform and PE bags at home for any rogue items that children may have scooped up and put in their bag by mistake. If you do find any items that don't belong to your child/ren, please hand them in to the school office. Many thanks.

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Please send your children into school wearing plenty of layers; tracksuit bottoms and sweaters for PE; and hats and gloves. Sports lessons and break times will continue to take place outside whenever possible this term. PE kits must be in school every day. Please also remember wellies if it is snowy.
