They started with fossil handling and a discussion about the different types of fossils, before splitting into groups to learn more about how fossils are formed and the different kinds of dinosaurs - particularly how to identify them. The children were impeccably well behaved and Miss Pearce said it was lovely to see the children sharing their knowledge, as well as learning and remembering new facts.

- PE kits are being sent home today, as they are quite wet and dirty from today's sports rugby lessons. PE kits will not be required in school tomorrow so there is no need for washing tonight!
- Our end of term celebration assembly and Easter Service, with songs from each class, will take place tomorrow in Slingsby Church at 1pm. The children will return to school after the service but may leave early if you wish to take them. School will be open until 3.30pm as usual for those who are unable to collect earlier, and Sports Club will still be on until 4.30pm for any children booked in.

Attendance Reminder

Thank you to everyone for the concerted effort to improve punctuality and attendance. It has been very pleasing to note the very positive and direct impact this has had on learning and progress in school. As per our protocol, letters will be emailed out tomorrow notifying parents/carers if children have an attendance percentage of less than 95% for the year so far.

By way of reminder, attendance is closely monitored and we have a duty to report to Governors and the Local Authority. Children with attendance below 95% are flagged and reasons discussed so that if help is needed, we can offer that help to families. Our Attendance Policy is that children arriving in school **after 8:50am** must be accompanied by a responsible adult who is required to walk them to the front door, ring the bell and provide a reason for the late arrival. Arrival after the close of registration at 9am is classed as an unauthorised absence unless there is a genuine acceptable reason for lateness. For leave of absence during term time, parents/carers are required to complete the Application for Leave in Term Time form on our website six weeks in advance for consideration by Mr Smith. Mr Smith can only authorise leave in exceptional circumstances. Many thanks for your ongoing support.

Parent Pay – Please clear debt immediately

We are required to have nil debt on Parent Pay for the end of our financial year. Where possible, we have spent time transferring any credits you had on individual Parent Pay items over to the relevant debt items to clear debts that still remained on accounts. If there was no credit available, there will still be debt showing on your account. There is currently <u>£10.00</u> on Parent Pay. Please can you ensure that you have <u>NO</u> outstanding arears on your Parent Pay by the end of this month to help with our year end. As always, we request that all clubs and lunches are paid in advance to avoid accruing debt and assist with our financial management.
