Additional Information

- Please try and listen to your child read each evening. Your child will read with their teacher, once a week in a guided reading group and once every two weeks with a parent helper. When not reading with the teacher, they will work independently on reading tasks; for example: comprehension tasks, finding definitions of unfamiliar words and tasks to develop inference skills.
- Children will change their reading books when they have finished reading their current book.
- Spellings will be given to pupils every Tuesday and they will be tested on the following Monday, so children have the weekend to help learn them. Please encourage your child to complete their 'look, say, cover, write, check' grid and write a minimum of 3 interesting, extended sentences in their spelling homework books, using words from their list and a range of punctuation. The children can also use their spelling work books as a place to practice their times tables for their weekly test.
- Children will require their PE bags in school **all week** - including a pair of socks. PE sessions for Class 3 are timetabled to take place every Tuesday (swimming) and Thursday.
- Please actively encourage your child to learn the multiplication tables thoroughly, as sound knowledge will help their confidence in many areas of mathematics. They will have a daily 3-minute test to practice their times tables and a more formal test on Friday.
